# RULES

## ISEM YOUNG PHOTOGRAPHER AWARD FOR DOCUMENTARY PHOTOGRAPHY 2023

### ARTICLE 1 – PREAMBLE

**ImageSingulières**, managed by the association CéTàVOIR, whose registered office is 3 rue Pierre Brossolette 34200 Sète, SIRET n° 478 726 862 00012, Code APE : 9499Z.

ImageSingulières is the name of the Centre photographique documentaire (17 rue Lacan in Sète), a space dedicated to documentary photography open all year, and the festival of documentary photography ImageSingulières, organized in May in various sites around Sète.

hereinafter 'ImageSingulières',

**ETPA Ecoles Créatives**, whose registered office is at 50, Route de Narbonne – 31320 Auzeville Tolosane, SIRET n° 319 763 355 00066 Code APE : 8532Z.

ETPA, created in 1974 by Jean Lévy, is a photography school in Toulouse which providing photography courses designed to develop professionals. Its legal representative is Mr. Karim Khenissi.

hereinafter 'ETPA'

**The publishing company Mediapart**, whose registered office is at 8 passe Brulon, 75012 in Paris, SIRET N° 500 631 932 00034, Code APE: 5813Z.

The publishing company Mediapart was created on 24th October 2007. It publishes the online investigative and opinion journal Mediapart. The chairman and director of the publication is Edwy Plenel. Mediapart has been involved since its creation in defending photojournalism and documentary photography.

hereinafter 'Mediapart'

ImageSingulieres, ETPA and Mediapart are partnering to support young documentary photography through the ISEM Young Photographer Award for Documentar. The purpose of this document, hereinafter the 'Rules' is to define the terms of the Award.

### ARTICLE 2 –TERMS AND CONDITIONS

'The Young Photographer Award' is open to all photographers under 26 years old living in French territories hereinafter the 'Participant'.

One single creative project per Participant will be accepted per edition of the Young Photographer Award.

Applicants from previous editions have the option of entering the Young Photographer Award again provided they put forward previously unpublished and different work from that of the first edition.

### ARTICLE 3 – PROCESS & CONSTITUTION OF THE FILE

**Submission of applications from 2nd January to 15th March 2023 (until 11:59pm)**

Files received after midnight on 31st March 2021 will not be taken into consideration.

**File (10Mo maximum) to send by email only to the following address :**

An acknowledgement of receipt is sent when the application has been received. In the event of no receipt being received, no claims will be accepted.

The complete application file including:

- **a pdf horizontal format with a text presenting the project (one page maximum, french or english), a coherent series of 15 photos** (from the existing project), **and captions**
- **the completed and signed application form**
- **a CV outlining the student Participant's achievements** (courses, exhibitions, publications, awards, etc.)
- **a copy of ID and a proof of address in France.**

## ARTICLE 4- RESPONSABILITY OF THE PARTICIPANT

Any application completed with incomplete, incorrect or counterfeit information or contact details or produced in violation of these Rules is inadmissible and will be rejected, and as such the organizers cannot be held responsible.

The Participant guarantees that the artworks proposed to the Young Photographer Award are original, new and that they are the exclusive bearer of exploitation rights attached to these artworks. The Participant must obtain authorisation from any third-party, notably individuals depicted whose image is used.

If the works proposed include all or part of works by a third-party protected by copyright, the participant must disclose this in their file, by mentioning the name of the authors or rights holders concerned, for due consideration.

## ARTICLE 5 – AWARD

- The winner will receive **a grant of 2,000 (two thousand) euros** from to support them with their project.
- **The application portfolio will be projected during the Young Photographer Award prize giving on Saturday 20th May 2023** at ImageSingulières in Sète, **and published on the Mediapart website** in the weeks following presentation of the Award.
- The winner will receive support to develop their project from the ETPA team, by joining a **3rd year Masterclass of their choice**.

The winner will be invited to the Young Photographer Award prize giving in Sète. ImageSingulières will meet the costs of their travel expenses from mainland France and accommodation (2 nights in a hotel).

## ARTICLE 6 - DESIGNATION OF THE WINNER AND AWARD ALLOCATION

### 6.1 Pre-selection of Participants

All applications will be submitted to the jury anonymously. The jury will then study the applications and will meet in April 2023 to select the winner.

The jury's decision cannot be contested under any circumstances. No appeal can be made.

### 6.2 Selection of the winner

The Jury will comprise:

- Pierre Barbot, chairman of CÉTàVOIR
- Charlotte Cabanel, director of ETPA,
- Sébastien Calvet, chief editor of Mediapart,
- Valérie Laquittant director of ImageSingulières
- and Fabienne Pavia, publishing director of Le Bec en l'air.

### 6.3 Procedure for allocation of award

The winner will be informed by email and/or by telephone depending on the information provided in their application. If the information provided by the Participant at that time prevents them from being informed about their award, they will cease to be the winner and may not make any claim, the organizers may not be held liable.

The winner will receive the award of 2,000 (two thousand) euros at the Young Photographer Award prize giving ceremony on Saturday 20th May 2023 at ImageSingulières. A projection of the work submitted (15 images) by the winner will take place during the prize giving at ImageSingulières.

The winner will receive support to develop their project from the ETPA team, by joining a 3rd year Masterclass of their choice.

### 6.4 Authorisation

The winner authorises ImageSingulières, ETPA and Mediapart to:

- take photographs of the images from presenting their work at the Young Photographer Award
- use 5 images from their project submitted to the Young Photographer Award for the promotion of and communication about the Young Photographer Award on any media or by any processes hitherto known or unknown, worldwide and for a duration of 10 years renewable from the date of the announcement of the winner.
- use images for the publication of the portfolio on the Mediapart website ([www.mediapart.fr](http://www.mediapart.fr))

The winner also agrees to participate in interviews and reports to promote their work and the «ISEM Young Photographer Award».

#### **ARTICLE 7 - FORCE MAJEURE**

In the event of force majeure or if the circumstances so require, ImageSingulières reserves the right to change these rules, to postpone or cancel the Young Photographer Award. It will not be held liable in any way as a result of these changes.

#### **ARTICLE 8 – RULES**

Taking part in this Young Photographer Award implies full acceptance of these rules including, as they arise, any amendments and addenda.

#### **ARTICLE 9 – LITIGATION**

This Young Photographer Award is subject to French Law and to the High Court with territorial jurisdiction.
